

## Department of Transport and Community Safety Leads Efforts to Enhance Road Safety and Disaster Response in Limpopo

The Limpopo Department of Transport and Community Safety, led by MEC Mme Violet Mathye, remains committed to its mandate of promoting safe and efficient transport systems, and ensuring community safety.

The province recorded a 14% reduction in road crashes and a 10% decline in fatalities during the festive season, showcasing the department's efforts to enhance road safety. However, severe weather impacts have led to significant damage to road infrastructure and prompted the postponement of activities leading up to the Marula Festival.

"As we continue to respond to disasters and promote road safety, we reiterate our commitment to serving the people of Limpopo," said MEC Mathye.
