POLOKWANE: The MEC for Transport and Community Safety, Ms Violet Mathye together with the Provincial Commissioner of Police in Limpopo, Lieutenant General Thembi Hadebe, will on Friday, 13 February 2026, lead a joint handover programme aimed at supporting learners and families affected by the recent floods in the Mopani District.

The programme will include the distribution of school uniforms to learners at Nyiko Primary School and Masiza Secondary School in Mbaula Village. The delegation will further hand over food parcels to identified families at the New Creation Tabernacle of Grace (NITC) Church in Belleview Village.

The initiative forms part of ongoing efforts to restore dignity and provide relief to communities impacted by natural disasters in the province.
