Team Vhembe Closes January Month By Enforcing The Law, To Ensure Safety.

The Limpopo Department of Transport and Community Safety is pleased to commend Team Vhembe Traffic Officers for their exceptional work in Musina and Thohoyandou. A special Warrant of Arrest operation conducted on January 30, 2026, resulted in the payment of 32 outstanding traffic fines. Additionally, a bus was impounded for transporting 47 Malawian passengers to Johannesburg without a permit and is currently held at the Musina TCC holding yard for further investigation.

In another operation conducted on January 29, 2026, officers impounded 6 maxi taxis for operating without licenses, conveying passengers from Musina Town to Beitbridge. The Vhembe Public Transport Unit (PTU) operation, which took place from 05H00 to 13H00, involved checking 90 vehicles, issuing 13 summonses, and impounding 13 vehicles.
