TWENTY-SEVEN DRUNK DRIVERS NABBED IN WEEKEND CRACKDOWN

Traffic law enforcement officers in Limpopo arrested 27 motorists for driving under the influence of alcohol during an intensive weekend operation conducted from Friday, 3 October to Sunday, 5 October 2025.

The arrests involved drivers aged between 22 and 61 years. The highest recorded blood alcohol level was 1.09, followed by readings of 0.78 and 0.72, all far above the legal limit.

Operations were carried out across all districts in the province, with arrests recorded in Letsitele, Namakgale and Maake in the Mopani, Saselamani in the Vhembe, Marble Hall in the Sekhukhune, and Bela-Bela and Lephalale in the Waterberg.

These arrests form part of ongoing efforts to clamp down on impaired driving and enhance road safety across the province. The Department continues to urge members of the public to report reckless or drunk driving to authorities for swift action.

Together, let's choose responsibility over recklessness and make Limpopo's roads safer for everyone.
