**CAPRICORN DISTRICT: TRAFFIC ARREST REPORT:**

The Limpopo Department of Transport and Community Safety reports that a 36-year-old male Taxi driver was arrested at the Polokwane Indian Centre Taxi Rank for failing to pay outstanding traffic fines.

A warrant of arrest had been issued against the motorist after he failed to comply with legal processes and failed to appear in court. He was subsequently arrested by the South African Police Service (SAPS) in Polokwane on charges of failure to appear in court. The suspect was later granted bail.

The Department of Transport and Community Safety appeals to all motorists to pay their traffic fines and comply with road traffic regulations, as law enforcement authorities are intensifying operations to arrest motorists with outstanding warrants related to unpaid traffic fines.
