LIMPOPO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORT AND COMMUNITY SAFETY TO IMPLEMENT CASHLESS PAYMENT SYSTEM

The Limpopo Department of Transport and Community Safety would like to remind members of the public that from the 1st August 2026 it will migrate from cash payments to a fully cashless payment system at all its service points across the province.

Members of the public paying for traffic fines, vehicle licence discs, driver's licence applications and renewals, abnormal load permits, and all other services offered by the Department will be required to use approved cashless payment methods. No cash payments will be accepted.

The following payment options will be available:

1. Debit/Credit Cards – Tap, swipe, or insert.
2. EFT/Instant Payments – Secure electronic bank transfers.
3. Mobile Payments – Scan-to-Pay and other approved digital payment platforms.

The introduction of the cashless payment system forms part of the Department's efforts to improve service delivery, enhance security, promote transparency, and provide convenient payment options for customers.

Members of the public are encouraged to prepare for this transition and make use of the available electronic payment methods when visiting any Departmental service point from 1 August 2026.
